Subject: Outstanding Dues against CHB Allottees

Detail of outstanding dues against the allottees of Chandigarh Housing Board has been uploaded on the website <u>www.chbonline.in</u>. These details have been updated upto 31st May or 30th June 2020. All the allottees are requested to clear the pending dues without any further delay to avoid cancellation of their units.

- 2. The payment of dues can be made in either of the following way:
 - I. <u>Online Payment:</u> The online payments can be made by visiting website <u>www.chbonline.in</u> without any additional charges, through Debit Card, Credit Card and online banking. This is better way of payment and to further encourage the online payments, a computerized draw is being held every month to give a reward of Rs. 1000/- each to 10 online payment transactions.
- **II. Offline Payment:** The allottees may generate a challan by visiting website of the CHB and then make the payment (through Cash/Cheque/Draft) in any of the branch of HDFC within the Chandigarh City. For generation of such challan, the basic data of the allottee will be fetched from the database provided by the CHB to avoid any mistake and early credit of the payment. The manually filled challans are NOT accepted by the HDFC Bank while accepting payment for CHB. However to facilitate those allottees that do not have internet facility or facing any difficulty in generation of challan, the following Branches of HDFC bank have been identified to assist in generation of challans:
 - a) HDFC Bank Branch at Sector- 9 D,
 - b) HDFC Bank Branch at Sector- 22 B,
 - c) HDFC Bank Branch at Sector -37 D
 - d) HDFC Bank Branch at Industrial Phase I & II

3. All the allottees of the Chandigarh Housing Board are requested to make online payments, as far as possible. However for any reason, if offline payment is made through cash/cheque/draft, then a challan need to be generated from the website of the Chandigarh Housing Board to make payment in any branch of the HDFC Bank in Chandigarh.
