

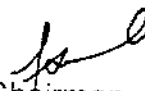

ORDER

The Board in its 421st meeting held on 06.08.2020, vide agenda item No 421.4.5 observed that once the Sale Deed for a free-hold property has been registered by the Sub-Registrar, U.T., Chandigarh, either directly by the owner or through his/her General Power of Attorney, the Chandigarh Housing Board needs to treat both the cases at par for the purpose of recording the transfer in its record.

Accordingly, the Board, vide the agenda item No 421.4.5, has decided that the transfer charges @ 15% of the consideration amount and stamp duty will not be applicable in those cases where free-hold CHB dwelling unit is transferred through duly registered Sale-Deed.
