The Chandigarh Administration, vide order no. EO-61871/F-4369/FII-(6)/2021/4640 dated 27.04.2021, has appointed the undersigned as the Nodal Officer for managing medical oxygen supply in UT, Chandigarh.

- 2. Further the Chandigarh Administration vide order no. PS/AA/562 dated 06.05.2021 had assigned the charge to Shri Jagjit Singh, PCS for coordinating with all private hospitals located in Chandigarh regarding their availability of beds and supply of medical oxygen.
- 3. During a meeting on 22.05.2021 with Private Hospitals and Private Refilling Vendors which was chaired by Shri Jagjit Singh, PCS, some of the Private Hospitals made a complaint that M/s Super Agencies has over-charged from them. Though the re-filling charges for 'D' Type Cylinders were fixed as Rs. 295/- plus 12%v GST but they were forced to pay between Rs. 600/- to Rs. 800/- by M/s Super Agencies. Since a quota and Refilling Vendor was fixed by the Administration, they had to pay the demanded extra money to M/s Super Agencies. Despite repeated calls, M/s Super Agencies did not attend the meeting on the pretext of being ill.
- 4. The following Private Hospitals who made the complaints of the overcharging have been requested to submit a written complaint to appropriate strict action in the matter:
 - Mukut Hospital i.
 - Healing Hospital ii.
- Kare Partners Hospital iii.
- City/Apollo Hospital iv.

5. Shri Jagjit Singh, PCS will deal with the complaints, after going through facts of the case and giving an opportunity of hearing to all concerned parties. Anybody who taken any undue advantage will not be spared and lodging of FIR with the police will also be considered.
