Subject: Association of volunteers of National Service Scheme (NSS) with the activities for prevention of vector borne diseases


As you are aware, considering delayed rain during the month of September this year, there are considerable number of cases of Malaria/Dengue are being reported every day. The Health Department is taking all sort of preventive and punitive measures to control the vector borne diseases. The measure includes:

- i. Awareness & education programmes at different locations in the city
- ii. Fogging and Spray at public/private places in co-ordination with the Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh
- iii. Checking and inspection of vulnerable places
- iv. Notices /Show Cause Notices and Challans/Fines upon the Private and Government premises

2. In past at several occasions, the volunteers of the NSS have been associated with many initiatives of the Health Department. It is requested that about 100 volunteers of the NSS may please be associated with the Health Department to assist for Malaria/Dengue related activities from Monday i.e. 18.10.2021 to 31.10.2021. Here it may please be ensured that :

- The volunteers should be college student only. None of the school student should be associated.
- The volunteer must be of more than 18 years of age and fully vaccinated for COVID. Hence must have taken both the doses of the COVID vaccination.
