(Policy decision about Transfer of Small Flats under Chandigarh Small Flats Scheme-2006 where both the allottees have expired, after allotment)

Shri Dharampal, Adviser to Administrator and Chairman Chandigarh Housing Board has decided that where both the allottees (Husband & Wife) have expired, after the allotment of Small Flats, a fresh license will be created in favour of the surviving heirs subject to following conditions:

- They are residing in the premises.
- They are not involved in any criminal case/activity.
- The dwelling unit is properly maintained without any violation.
- The Licence fee of the dwelling unit have been duly paid in time.
- They fulfill the other conditions and guidelines of the Chandigarh Small Flats Scheme-2006.

Shri Dharampal further stated that this decision will settle all the pending cases and will provide a relief to a hundreds of surviving heirs of allottees where both the parent have expired and transfer of the dwelling unit was pending in absence of the policy decision.
