Subject: Revival of allotment of Dwelling Unit No. 1788, Sector 29 B, Chandigarh.

Kindly refer to the Orders dated 08.11.2022 of worthy Chairman, CHB conveyed by the Secretary, CHB vide No. 1468 dated 05.12.2022 on the subject cited above.

Whereas the allotment and registration of **Dwelling Unit No. 1788, Category EWS, Sector 29 B, Chandigarh** was allotted Sh. Rajinder Singh Chatha S/o Sh. Kehar Singh Chatha vide Allotment Letter No. 699 dated 08.10.1982 & further the said dwelling unit was transfer in favour of Sh. Sanjeev Kumar Sharma S/o Sh. Roshan Lal Sharma on the basis of GPA Transfer Policy vide No. 9458 dated 24.07.2003.

And whereas Registration/Allotment of dwelling unit No. 1788, Cat. EWS, Sector 29 B, Chandigarh which was transferred in your name had been cancelled vide No. 323 dated 03.12.2015 due to Building violation in terms of provision of clause 19 of the allotment letter on account of breach of terms and conditions of allotment and also the provision of Regulation, 17 of Chandigarh Housing Board (Allotment management and Sale of Tenements) Regulation, 1979.

And whereas your appeal was placed before the Chairman, CHB on 17.12.2015. The Board resolved that D.U. No. 1788 Cat. EWS, Sector 29 B, Chandigarh may be restored subject to payment of revival charges as per existing policy.

Whereas, you have deposited the Revival Charges Rs. Rs. 43,607/- including GST on 16.01.2023.

Now, therefore, the allotment of dwelling unit No.1788, Cat. EWS, Sector 29 B, Chandigarh is hereby revived on the original terms and conditions as per allotment dated 08.10.1982.

This issues with the approval of worthy Chairman, CHB orders dated 08.11.2022.
