

 - Three similar works each costing not less than Rs.3.12 Lakh or two similar works each of costing not less than Rs.4.68 or one similar work of costing not less than Rs.6.24 Lakh

Similar work shall mean " Civil Work"

Components of work executed other than those included in definition of similar work shall be deducted while calculating cost of similar work. Bidder shall submit abstract of cost of work in support of this.

The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum; calculated from the date of completion to the last date of submission of bld.



Firm/Contractors, against whom any criminal proceedings are pending in any court of law relating to any project executed by the firm, shall not be considered for post-qualification. To become eligible, for e-tendering, the tenderer shall

have to furnish an affidavit as per Annexure-I.

d) GST registration Certificate, if already obtained by the bidder.

A bidders shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidder implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

The competent authority on behalf of the Chairman, CHB does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without assigning any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tenderer, the same shall be summarily rejected.

12. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection



13. The competent authority on behalf of the Chairman, Chandigarh Housing Board reserves with himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.

14. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CHB Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the CHB. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be debarred in participating

tender in CHB. No Engineer of Gazetted rank or other Gazetted officer employed in the Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from

Government service, without the previous permission of the Chairman, CHB in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found at any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Chairman, CHB as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractor's service.




