

**EVICTON ORDER**

**U/s 51 Sub-Section (1) of Haryana Housing Board, Act  
(as extended to Chandigarh)**

To

Sh. Ram Karan S/o Sh. Ram Dev /Occupant  
Flat No.2154, Sector 39 (West) Maloya  
Chandigarh

Whereas I, the undersigned, am satisfied that you have unauthorizely occupied the Flat No.2154, Sector 39 (West) Maloya, Chandigarh (ARHCs) from 02.02.2026. The allotment of the dwelling unit has been cancelled by the Chandigarh Housing Board, Chandigarh vide order No.6778-79 dated 02.02.2026 due to non- payment.

And whereas vide Eviction Notice No.305 dated 13.03.2026, you were directed to tender an explanation and produce evidence, if any, within 14 days from the date of the service of the notice. But you failed to tender an explanation and produce evidence.

And thereby you have acted in contravention of the terms & conditions under which you were authorized to occupy and use the premises schedule given below Flat No.2154, Sector 39 (West) Maloya, Chandigarh (ARHCs).

Now, therefore, in exercise of the Powers conferred on me by Sub-Section (1) of Section 51 of Haryana Housing Board, Act, 1971 as extended to the Union Territory of Chandigarh, I hereby again order you (as well as other occupants who is/are in occupation of the whole/a part of the said premises), to vacate the said premises within one month from the date of service of this notice, failing which you may be evicted forcibly unless you comply with the terms contravened by you.
