

(Eviction Order)
U/s 51 Sub-Section (1) of Haryana Housing Board Act
(as extended to Chandigarh)

To

Sh. Durga Singh S/o Sh. Ram Surat Singh,

Whereas, the undersigned, is satisfied that you have unauthorizedly occupied the DU No. 2623/3, Small Flats, Sector 49, Chandigarh from 03.01.2025. The allotment of the dwelling unit has been cancelled by Chandigarh Housing Board, Chandigarh vide order No. 217-18 dated 03.01.2025 due to non payment.

And whereas vide Eviction Notice No. 636 dated 07.03.2025, you were directed to tender an explanation and produce evidence, if any, within 14 days from the date of the service of the notice.

And thereby you have acted in contravention of the terms under which you were authorized to occupy and use the premises **DU No. 2623/3, Small Flats, Sector 49, Chandigarh.**

Now, therefore, in Exercise of the Powers conferred by Sub Section (1) of Section 51 of the Haryana Housing Board Act, 1971 (as extended to the Union Territory of Chandigarh), it is hereby ordered that you (as well as other occupants who is/are in occupation of the whole/a part of the said premises) shall vacate the said premises within **one month** from the date of service of notice under Sub-Section (1) of Section 51 of the act, failing which you may be evicted forcibly.
