Whereas, the undersigned is satisfied that you have unauthorizely occupied the Small Flat No. 4884/3, Sector 38 (West), Chandigarh from 16.12.2024. The allotment of the dwelling unit has been cancelled by the Chandigarh Housing Board, Chandigarh vide order No.18894-95 dated 16.12.2024 due to non payment.

And whereas you have acted in contravention of the terms under which you were authorized to occupy and use the premises described in the Schedule appended hereto:-

And whereas, in Exercise of the Powers conferred on me by Sub Section (1) of Section 51 of the Haryana Housing Board Act, 1971, as extended to the Union Territory of Chandigarh, I propose to order you (as well as other occupant of Small Flat No.4884/3, Sector 38 (West), Chandigarh, who is/are in occupation of the whole/a part of the said premises) to vacate the said premises within one month from the date of service of notice under Sub-Section (1) of Section 51 of the act, on the grounds aforesaid (herein after referred to as the proposed orders).
