

EVICTON ORDER
U/s 51 Sub-Section (1) of Haryana Housing Board, Act
(as extended to Chandigarh)

To

Sh.Chandan Singh S/o Sh.Ghoora Singh.
House No.170/2, Sector 41-A
Chandigarh

Whereas I, the undersigned, am satisfied that you have unauthorizely occupied the Dwelling Unit No.170/2, Sector 41-A, Chandigarh from 10.03.2025. The allotment of the dwelling unit has been cancelled by the Chandigarh Housing Board, Chandigarh vide CEO, CHB order No.2010970 dated 10.03.2025 due to building violations under Clause 15 of allotment letter.

And whereas vide Eviction Notice No.970 dated 07.05.2025, you were directed to tender an explanation and produce evidence, if any, within 14 days from the date of the service of the notice. But you failed to tender an explanation and produce evidence.

And thereby you have acted in contravention of the terms & conditions under which you were authorized to occupy and use the premises schedule given below Dwelling Unit No.170/2, Sector 41-A, Chandigarh.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the Powers conferred on me by Sub-Section (1) of Section 51 of Haryana Housing Board, Act, 1971 as extended to the Union Territory of Chandigarh, I hereby again order you (as well as other occupants who is/are in occupation of the whole/a part of the said premises), to vacate the said premises within one month from the date of service of this notice, failing which you may be evicted forcibly unless you comply with the terms contravened by you.
